Nottinghamshire Masons to climb Mt Kilimanjaro In aid of the 2018 Festival.

Located in Tanzania, Mt Kilimanjaro is Africa's highest mountain rising 19,341ft (5,895m) above sea level. A dormant volcanic mountain capped by 3 volcanic craters. A team of Nottinghamshire Freemasons will attempt to reach the summit during the summer of 2016 in the hope of gaining generous sponsorship support for the festival.

Led by Bro Les Boyington who will be Worshipful Master of St Peter's Lodge and accompanied by the Festival Director W Bro Peter Gregory, experienced mountaineer Bro Barry Harper and other equally crazy brethren and friends the team expect to reach the summit in 10 days. All expedition members are self funded and all sponsorship received will be attributed to the festival. Although it is considered by some as one of the most climbable of mountains the elevation gives rise to serious altitude sickness and includes hazards such as high winds and frequent snow storms.
